



9 Wainwrights for 90 years

Celebrate 90 years of NE Youth with us on our special lake district challenge event on Friday 10th October 2025

Take in the stunning scenery of one of the UK's natural wonders, the lake district, as you visit 9 of the famous Wainwrights in aid of the region's young people. It's a walk with experienced guides, who will help navigate the mountain paths from start to finish.

We'll set off on in the morning together and walk the bucket-list Fairfield Horseshoe – a 12-mile route starting and ending at Grasmere. Some great views at the peaks are the reward for the effort and the walk ends with a leisurely walk in the grounds of Rydal Hall, past waterfalls and soaring peaks either side.

This route covers well laid mountain paths throughout and takes us across NINE Wainwrights along the way: Nab Scar, Heron Pike, Stone Arthur, Great Rigg, Fairfield, Hart Crag, Dove Crag, High Pike and Low Pike. As such, it is the go-to way of starting any Wainwright journey and an impressive talking point once completed as a challenge.
